Eligibility Requirements:

- African-American students enrolled in a undergraduate business or management program at an accredited academic institution in Fall 2011. Eligible students must:
 - Attend an academic institution located in Northern California or
 - Be a resident of Northern California enrolled in any accredited academic institution

Application Requirements:

Completed application form (enclosed) including a 1,000 word response to one (1) of the following essay questions:

1. What do you think is the greatest challenge facing African-American youth and how can it be overcome? What role will you play in helping them overcome this challenge?
2. What can African-Americans do to become more marketable in today's global economy?
3. What recommendations would you give to colleges and universities looking to attract more minority students? Discuss what current students and the business community can do to help.
4. Why has hip hop gained so much influence on African American youth? What can university and business communities do to spread the word about other roles African Americans have in U.S. and global business?

1. Copy of most recent college transcript or full four-year high school transcript (if first year undergraduate business student)
 2. Proof of enrollment and registration in Fall 2011 (photocopy is acceptable)
 3. Resume including a summary of any extracurricular / volunteer / community service activities
- Prior to submitting your electronic application, submit all other documentation in one mailing. Incomplete applications will NOT be considered. Submitted materials will not be returned.




